While most would agree that lacking diversity in your portfolio is a huge mistake, you might be surprised to learn that too much diversity can also be a problem. For those who might need a quick refresher, portfolio diversification involves spreading your investments across multiple types of assets (stocks, bonds, short- and long-term investments, etc.). We spoke with Shinobu Hindert, CFP and author of "Investing Is Your Superpower," about the good and the bad of portfolio diversification. Hindert said, "For new investors, I recommend considering an allocation fund or using a robo-adviser. These options provide a balanced approach to diversification while giving you access to professional advice without the need to manage your investments daily."

WW Money questions answered

Q: My mom passed away and left behind credit card balances and other debt. As the beneficiary of her life insurance policy, do I have to pay off what she owes with the money I received?

It's not unusual for people to have debt when they die. Credit bureau Experian reports 73% of us will leave behind bills, most commonly from credit cards and mortgages. The good news for life insurance beneficiaries: "If the beneficiary of the life insurance policy is a person and not the estate, the beneficiary is generally not required to pay estate debts with the proceeds," says Shinobu Hindert, certified financial planner at EmpoweredPlanning.com and author of *Investing Is Your Superpower*.

"If the estate doesn't have enough money to cover outstanding debts, then creditors may try to make a claim against the life insurance policy, but it's rare," she notes. These are handled on a case-by-case basis and are state-specific, so if a creditor approaches you, contact an estate attorney.

Debts you may owe

In most cases, debt solely in the name of the deceased person is covered by their estate, or if there isn't enough, it goes unpaid. "The only time creditors can really come after an individual is if they had shared debts—for example, if you're both on a mortgage," says Hindert. Same goes for credit cards. As long as you aren't sharing an account, you aren't expected to pay balances. One exception is for surviving spouses who live in a community property state (Arizona, California, Idaho, Louisiana, Nevada, New Mexico, Texas, Washington and Wisconsin) who may have to use jointly owned property to pay their spouse's debts.

Hindert does caution there's one kind of debt you may not realize you agreed to pay: medical debt. "When you admit someone into a hospital or long-term care facility, you're asked to sign paperwork. A lot of times, there's language that says you're responsible for paying," she says. "So when signing medical forms, be careful."

What about bank accounts?

If you have a joint bank account with both your name and your parent's name on it, the funds in it will still be available to you as the surviving account holder. If you're a payable-upon-death beneficiary, then the funds would also be sent to you. In both cases, generally you do not have to use these funds to cover your parent's debts.

Q: I'd like to put more money toward retirement, but at 55, am I too late?

There's good news for people 50 and older: "Reaching age 50 allows you to put more money into tax-advantaged retirement accounts," says Brandon Renfro, Ph.D., certified financial planner at BelongingWealth.com. "For IRAs, you can put an extra \$1,000 in per year. For workplace plans like a 401(k), you can add an additional \$7,500 on top of the standard limit." For 2024, this means you can put \$8,000 into an IRA, and participants in 401(k), 403(b) and most 457 plans, and the federal government's Thrift Savings Plan, can put in up to \$30,500. "These 'catch-up' contributions, as they are called, can help you do just that—catch up on retirement savings if you're behind."



Adults in the United States need a money management makeover, and they need it quickly.

Case in point: almost 50% of Americans have \$500 or less in their bank savings accounts, and only 29% of American adults have between \$501 and \$5,000 in those accounts, per a recent study from [GoBankingRates](#).

The same study finds 60% of Americans have more than \$500 in their checking account.

It's easy to point out that record high inflation, a hangover from pandemic-driven lockdowns, and poor savings habits are largely responsible for the lack of savings among the U.S. population, but that's water under the bridge.

Now, Americans with limited income need both a savings plan and an investing plan. 

As the 2024 presidential election heats up, you may wonder what it means for your money. 
